



If you are building a backyard halfpipe you will want to top layer the ramp with a proper ramp surfacing. Skatelite or Ramp Armor Deluxe are the best choices for you. The sheets need to be shipped to your home or a local business for pick up. The sheets of ramp surfacing are about 55 lbs each and are banded on 4x8 pallets and shipped on large carriers such as USF, TGR or Oak Harbor Freight- not UPS.



Damaged Shipment: If your ramp surfacing arrives damaged with large tears in the packaging and broken pieces, immediately take inventory of the damaged pieces and have the delivery driver sign off on the slip that a certain number of pieces were damaged. If you have a digital camera, take several photographs of the damage. Call www.rampsurface.com and we will help begin the replacement process. The shipment often passes between several different carrier companies before arriving to you. This can make the blame game a difficult and long process so if the sheets can be flipped over and used, sometimes that's the best solu-

tion. After a damage claim is filed, most trucking companies will want to pick up the damaged sheets as salvage, keep the pallet so the shipping company can pick up the salvaged pieces easier. This will help speed up the claim process.



This backyard ramp was sheeted in Skatelite Pro in the natural color. The sheets were 4x8 in size and 1/4" thick. The sheets of Skatelite (not skatelight) were fastened down to the ramp using 2" outdoor decking screws. Special four flute countersinks were used to countersink the holes for the screws in a specific grid pattern so the screws hit the studs below and held down the sheets thoroughly.
